On-line applications are invited through the website at www.wbhealth.gov.in for admission to three years GNM Training course including six-month internship in Nursing Training Schools under Deptt. of Health & Family Welfare.

Total No. of Seats under Deptt of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal ----- 2300 (for female) + 105 (for male) [Changeable] = 2405

Reservation of Seats

- Scheduled Caste candidates: 22%
- Scheduled Tribe candidates: 6%
- Other Backward Classes Category-A candidates: 10%
- Other Backward Classes Category-B candidates: 7%
- Female Candidates belonging to Orphanages and Inmates of Destitute Homes recognized by the Social Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal : 2% only for State Government Institutes under Health & Family welfare Department.
- Lady Civil Defence Volunteers under Home (Civil Defence) Department, Govt. of West Bengal : 2.5% only for State Government Institutes under Health & Family welfare Department.
- P.W.D. candidates (**Persons with disabilities**) : 3% . As per INC norms, 3% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for each nursing programme.

Criteria for selection for On-line application)

- 1) Age : Between 17 to 27 years as on 1st January, Year of admission
- 2) The candidate must be a citizen of India and a permanent resident of the district of West Bengal (from where the candidate applies) uninterruptedly for at least five years preceding the date of submission of application.
- 3) Candidates must be able to read, write and express in **Bengali/Nepali**.
- 4) Minimum Educational Qualification: Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) Passed from West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or passed equivalent examination from any recognized Council/Board **with 40% qualifying marks** in English.

- 5) Selection will be made strictly on the basis of total marks obtained in compulsory subjects [Languages out of which English must be one **with 40% qualifying marks** and three Elective subjects (best three) except Environmental Education] **with 40% qualifying marks** in the H.S. (10+2) or equivalent Examination. Selection is subject to verification of mark-sheet from H.S. Council/concerned authority. In case of science students, candidates must obtain pass marks in both practical and theory separately and 40% in aggregate.
- 6) Application is to be made as per on-line pro-forma floated in the website. All the columns should be filled up properly. No application will be entertained if necessary documents are not furnished or not completed as per pro-forma.
- 7) During verification, applications must be accompanied by original and self-attested or attested by Group-A officer photocopies (whichever is applicable) of documents –
- i) Photo copy of Mark-sheet of H.S. Examination or equivalent examination,
 - ii) Age proof certificate (Madhyamik Admit Card/Certificate) ,
 - iii) **Original copy** of the Residential Certificate as prescribed format in the advertisement, issued only by a Government Gazetted Officer of the concerned District where the candidate resides/ Sabhadhipati of local Zilla Parishad/ Sabhapati of local Panchayet Samity/Prodhan of local Gram-Panchayet /Mayor or Councillor of local Municipal Corporation/ Chairman of local Municipality/ Ward Councillor of local Municipality /Local M.P/Local M.L.A mentioning that the candidate has been residing there permanently or for the period of last five (5 Yrs) years till date,
 - iv) Caste certificate issued by the a) **Sub-Divisional Officer of the Sub Division concerned District**
b) In Kolkata- **District Welfare Officer, Kolkata/ Ex- Officio Jt. Director or Deputy Director, Backward Classes Welfare Department.** (Applicable for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B Candidates only),
 - v) Civil Defence Certificate issued by the Officer-in-Charge of the concerned Department to the effect of availing Civil Defence Training and self-attested photocopy of Membership Certificate of casualty service, Civil Defence with Serial No. issued by the Officer commanding (applicable for Lady Civil Defence volunteers only),
 - vi) Orphanage and inmate-ship (of at least 5 years) in the concerned Destitute Homes recognized by the Social Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal (Applicable for Orphanage/inmates of Destitute Homes and for **female** candidates only),
 - vii) PWD certificate issued by the Medical Officer authorized by Medical Board of State Govt. ,

viii) One recent colour self-signed passport size photograph which is to be uploaded .

ix) Signature of the candidate should be uploaded.

Criteria for selection for On-line application

- For on-line submission of the application, criteria should be same as mentioned above from Sl. No- 1 to 5.
- All the seven documents (mentioned at Sr. No- 7 above) should be submitted in Original along with their self-attested photocopies at the time of Counselling, date of which will be determined later on.
- If any candidate (Female) provisionally selected for both G.N.M. training course/ ANM(R) training course, their candidature will be verified for both courses in the verification centre as per prescribed district. Finally, she will be admitted for any of the single course as per her choice.

8) **Provisionally Selected Applicant** should attend to the respective District at the mentioned School of Nursing for provisional Counselling and Verification with medical check-up by the constituted Committee as below: -The candidates who will fail to appear on the specified date will not be reconsidered.

9) To provide employment to the candidates, after completion of the training, is **not to be taken as an obligation on the part of the Govt.** of West Bengal.

10) After completion of verification and Medical fitness, provisionally selected candidates list will be published and called for the training according to serial number as per panel. There will be **no obligation** on the part of the Government of West Bengal to ensure training to all medically fit candidates.

11) The Selected Candidates will have to undergo training in their own choice allotted GNM training schools in West Bengal as day-scholar for the 1 year and they will **not** get hostel accommodation in the training institution during this period. The candidates themselves will have to arrange their accommodation for this 1 year to pursue the training course. After this period, they will have to undergo training residentially in the training institution, if provided.


12) The selected Candidates for the Govt. GNM School of Nursing have to pay an amount of Rs.12/- per month as establishment charge and a certain amount of money (to be fixed by concerned training school authority) towards messing charge.

13) During the period of training if any unlawful activity or violation of rules and regulations of the training course is committed by any candidate, she/he will be discharged from the training course.

14) No individual intimation will be given to the candidate about rejection.




